## EIT Plus: Concept of Education-Research-Innovation Triangle for Lower Silesia

Lower Silesian universities prepared a package of key projects for the Programme Innovative Economy in order to achieve a crucial progress on the way to Knowledge Based Economy in the Region. The goal of the investment project is building the Lower Silesian Centre for Materials and Biomaterials. The project will enable to concentrate research activities in fields which constitute strong points of Wroclaw as an academic and technological centre and will increase the competitiveness of the Lower Silesian Region and its position in EU. DolBioMat will support the development of basic research in the field of advanced materials, biomaterials and advanced medical technologies creating strong foundations for innovations, their application and technological research.

DolBioMat will be a basic instrument for building in this UE region a Central European Knowledge and Innovation Community – integral part of European Institute of Technology (EIT).
